**Under this agreement for 2018
Hendra State School will receive**

\$26,912*

This funding will be used to:

- increase the percentage of students meeting National Minimum Standards in Writing to 100% in Year 3 and Year 5
- increase the percentage of students meeting Upper Two Bands (U2B) in NAPLAN Writing in Year 3 to 30%
- increase the percentage of students meeting U2B in NAPLAN Writing in Year 5 to 60%
- increase the percentage of students receiving 'C' or above in achievement levels, with Writing assessments to 100%
- increase the percentage of Prep students meeting PM Level 9 Benchmarks in 2018 to 80%.

Our initiatives include:

- employing a Curriculum Leader to assist facilitation of improvements in writing through the joint initiative of the small schools cluster
- building teacher capacity in the teaching of writing and editing of writing
- providing targeted intervention through a speech pathologist and 'Read it Again' oral language program.

Our school will improve student outcomes by:

Employing small schools curriculum advisor.	\$13 580
Purchasing speech pathologist 0.2 to provide oral language program to Prep/Year 1 students.	\$ 8 500
Providing additional time for Principal to build teacher capacity and coach staff with C2C planning and implementation (school purchased classroom teacher .05).	\$ 4 235
Professional Learning – Writing.	\$ 597
