- Increase percentage of Year 1 students meeting PM Level 19 Benchmark in 2017 to 40%.
- Increase percentage of Year 2 students meeting PM Level 24 Benchmark in 2017 to 40%.

Our initiatives include

Instruction:

- Reviewing student performance data in five weekly cycles.
- Building teacher capacity in explicit teaching and consolidations through Professional Learning and coaching.
- Providing targeted intervention through speech pathologist and 'Read it Again' Oral Language Program.
- Providing additional Teacher Aides for sound, sight word and guided reading consolidation daily.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

Employing support staff to provide assistance with Instructional Reading Program. Duration of 1 year; 2 Teacher Aides/ 20 hours/week.	\$12,742.00
Purchasing Speech Pathologist 0.2 to provide Oral Language Program to Prep/ Year 1 students.	\$8500.00
Additional time for Principal to build teacher capacity and coach staff with C2C planning and implementation (school purchased c/room teacher .06).	\$4234.94
Professional Learning with continued PEAAC support in collaboration with Brisbane Small schools cluster.	1,435.06
